ELIGIBILITY

Students must:

1. Attend Westmont High School.
2. Have 2 years of membership in the Interact Club.
3. Have a minimum of 60% participation in activities, meetings, and events sponsored by the Interact Club.

REQUIREMENTS

Students must:

1. Submit a completed application.
2. Submit a well composed essay.
3. Submit a copy of his/her current high school transcript.
4. Finalists will be selected to give a speech at a Rotary Club dinner on March 10, 2020. This presentation will be based on the question: what does Rotary's *Four Way Test* mean to you? Candidates must prepare a well thought-out response on the topic.

1. Is it the TRUTH?
2. Is it FAIR to all concerned?
3. Will it build GOODWILL and BETTER FRIENDSHIPS?
4. Will it be BENEFICIAL to all concerned?
